

Dear guests,

Welcome! The current ordinance of the state of Rhineland-Palatinate to combat the corona virus includes the registration of overnight guests from abroad. We thank you for your understanding and your cooperation in the interests of everyone's health.

Many Thanks!

In accordance with the provisions of the applicable state ordinance to combat the corona virus (www.corona.rlp.de), overnight guests from abroad are only permitted if:

- Guests must **be symptom-free** upon arrival at the time of check-in.
- Guests must consult a doctor immediately if they have symptoms.
- If an infection is confirmed, the **accommodation provider must be informed immediately**, which will immediately inform the responsible health department.
- Guests who want to check in from a risk area **must provide evidence of their non-infection by means of a medical certificate**. The medical certificate must be based on a molecular biological test for the presence of an infection with the SARS-CoV-2 coronavirus, which was carried out in a member state of the European Union or in another country published by the Robert Koch Institute and carried out no more than 48 hours before entry has been.
- Guests who are not willing to comply with the above rules may not be granted accommodation.

I declare that I have read and understood the aforementioned provisions and my obligations.

I hereby declare legally binding, (please check the relevant box)

- that I am symptom-free.
- that I am not arriving from a risk area within the meaning of the aforementioned regulation and that I have not stayed in such a risk area in the past 14 days.
- that I have a medical certificate (testing not older than 48 hours before my check-in) with proof of non-infection and that this was presented to the accommodation facility as proof at the time of my check-in.
